NOTIFICATION

No. 279-PL/PB/3P-01/2022, dated 07.02.2022 : In exercise of the power conferred by section 2A of the Police Act, 1861, the Governor is pleased hereby to make the following rules regulating the recruitment to the post of Junior Constable in West Bengal Police under rehabilitation package for project affected people of Deocha-Pachami-Dewanganj-Harinsingha Coal Block and filling up of vacancies by making recruitment from amongst the eligible candidates residing in the said affected areas :-

Rules :

1. Short title and commencement :

- (1) These rules may be called the recruitment rule to the post of Junior Constable in West Bengal Police under rehabilitation package for project affected people of Deocha-Pachami-Dewanganj-Harinsingha Coal Block under West Bengal Police, 2022.
- (2) These rules shall come into effect on and from the date of this Publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Definitions :

In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,

- (i) 'Project affected people' means the people residing in Deocha-Pachami-Dewanganj-Harinsingha (DPDH) Coal Block under Md. Bazar Police Station of Birbhum District which has been allotted to WBPDCCL by Ministry of Coal, Government of India and the people living outside who are also having land within the said Coal Block area ;
- (ii) 'WBPRB' means West Bengal Police Recruitment Board as constituted vide Resolution No. 2624-PL, dated 09.07.2020 of the Home Department Government of West Bengal;

6. Physical Efficiency Test (PET):

- (a) For Male Candidates: 800 meter Run in maximum 4 Minutes.
All those who complete the run within 4 minutes will qualify for the post of Junior Constable.
- (b) For Female Candidate: 400 meter Run in maximum 2 Minutes 30 seconds.

9. Training:

Junior Constables will have to undergo the prescribed Training at Swami Vivekananda State Police Academy or Subsidiary Training Centre.

Period of probation should be two years.

10. Appointing Authority:

The Superintendent of Police of the concerned District will be the Appointing Authority of the Junior Constables.

11. Discharge:

During the training period any unsuitability of the candidate for the post as decided by the Training Authority will lead to the discharge of the candidate from the service without any formal departmental proceedings. However, the reason of such discharge from service will be intimated to him/her in writing.

The following points were discussed in the meeting of BOC for Examination & Promotion.

1. Filling up of upto date vacancies in the rank of ASI(UB) & ASI(AB) through departmental examination.

Member Secretary, West Bengal Police Recruitment Board has sought clarification regarding departmental examination towards filling up of upto date vacancies in the rank of ASI/ Lady ASI (UB) and ASI(AB) under his memo no.- PRB /Rectt.(Dept.) -ASI-4(Genl.)/2020 dtd- 5089 dtd- 28.10.2021.

He also informed that as per the provision under 3 (C) & 4 (C) of the GO No.- 4638 -PL dtd- 01.12.2008 "The departmental examination will be conducted by the Board of Control for examination and promotion". As per the provision the West Bengal Police Recruitment Board has no authority to conduct such promotional examination. It is also not clear to this board whether both Part-I (Written examination and drill weaponry examination) and Part- II (Length - Cum- Record of service) of the promotion process will be conducted by this Board.

Matter was placed before BOC for examination and promotion for decision.

Decision:- It was decided that immediate step is required to be taken for filling up 1178 Posts of ASI(UB) and 391 Posts of ASI(AB) under departmental examination quota laid down in GO No.- 4638-PL dtd- 01.12.2008 as stood on 01.10.2021. It was also decided that the said examination would be conducted by the West Bengal Police Recruitment Board. The vacancies occurring during the intervening period will also be taken into consideration at that time holding the departmental examination.

IGP, SVSPA, WB, Barrackpore has sent, under memo no.- SVSPA / Exam Sec/ PPT/ Const. (UB)/ 05(III)/2018 – 2353 DTD- 18.08.2021, the Result of the final examination of Post Promotional Training Course of Constable for promotion to the rank of ASI(UB) of Batch No.- 10/2021 .

Total 242 ASIs(UB) reported at STC, SAP, 4th BN. Kasba, Raiganj, to undergo the aforesaid training . All of them completed the training and appeared in the final examination in all subjects and qualified successfully.

The results of the same were placed before the 'Board of control' for examination and promotion for perusal and approval for taking next course of action.

Decision:- The board examined the results and approved of the same for next course of action 242 (two hundred forty two) ASI(UB) are found to have qualified for promotion.

(b) To examine and approve of the result of the final examination of Post Promotional Training Course of Constable for promotion to the rank of ASI (AB) , WBP of Batch No.- 10/2021 .

IGP, SVSPA , WB, Barrackpore has sent, under memo no.- SVSPA / Exam Cell/ PPT/ Const. (AB)/ 06(III)/2018 – 2354 DTD- 18.08.2021, the Result of the final examination of Post Promotional Training Course of Constable for promotion to the rank of ASI(AB) of Batch No.- 10/2021 .

Total 222 ASIs(AB) reported at STC, SAP, 4th BN. Kasba, Raiganj, to undergo the aforesaid training . 219 ASIs(AB) Candidates qualified out of 222 ASIs(AB) in all indoors and outdoors subject and remaining 03(three) candidates did not qualify in Paper-I : Law and procedure with book .

The results of the same were placed before the 'Board of control' for examination and promotion for perusal and approval for taking next course of action.

Decision:- The Board examined the results and approved of the same for next course of action 219 (two hundred nineteen) ASIs(AB) are found to have qualified for promotion.

(C) To examine and approve of the result of the final examination of Post Promotional Training Course of ASI(UB) for promotion to the rank of SI (UB) , WBP of Batch No.- 26/2021 .

IGP, SVSPA , WB, Barrackpore has sent, under memo no.- SVSPA / Exam Sec/ PPT/ ASI. (UB)/ 03(X)/2018 – 2355 DTD- 18.08.2021, the Result of the final examination of Post Promotional Training Course of ASI (UB) for promotion to the rank of SI(UB) of Batch No.- 26/2021 .

01 ASI(UB) had reported at SVSPA , WB, Barrackpore, WB to undergo the aforesaid training . The candidate completed the training and appeared in the final examination whereupon he has qualified in all subjects.

On the other hand 12 candidates of Previous Batch appeared as Supplementary Candidates of Batch no.- 25/2021 in the final examination in their respective subjects and all of them qualified successfully.

The results of the same were placed before the 'Board of control' for examination and promotion for perusal and approval for taking next course of action.

Decision:- The Board examined the results and approved of the same for next course of action 13 (thirteen) SIs(UB) are found to have qualified for promotion.

(d) To examine and approve of the result of the final examination of Pre/Post Promotional Training Course of ASI(UB) for promotion to the rank of SI (UB) , WBP of Batch No.- 27/2021 .

IGP, SVSPA, WB, Barrackpore has sent, under memo no.- SVSPA / Exam Sec/ PPT/ ASI. (UB)/ 03(XI)/2018 – 2897 DTD- 29.10.2021, the Result of the final examination of Pre/ Post Promotional Training Course of ASI (UB) for promotion to the rank of SI(UB) of Batch No.- 27/2021 .

146 SIs/ASIs(UB) had reported at SVSPA , WB, Barrackpore, WB to undergo the aforesaid training. 145 candidates out of 146 SIs/ASIs(UB), completed the training and appeared in the final examination and qualified in all subjects.

On the other hand 05 candidates of Previous Batch appeared as Supplementary Candidates of Batch no.- 25/2021 in the final examination in their respective subjects and all of them qualified successfully.

The results of the same were placed before the 'Board of control' for examination and promotion for perusal and approval for taking next course of action.

Decision:- The Board examined the results and approved of the same for next course of action 150 (One hundred fifty) SIs(UB) are found to have qualified for promotion.

(e) To examine and approve of the result of the final examination of Pre/Post Promotional Training

Course of ASI(AB) for promotion to the rank of SI (AB) , WBP of Batch No.- 21/2021 .

IGP, SVSPA, WB, Barrackpore has sent, under memo no.- SVSPA / Exam Sec/ PPT/ ASI. (AB)/ 04(IX)/2018 – 2896 DTD- 29.10.2021, the Result of the final examination of Pre/ Post Promotional Training Course of ASI (AB) for promotion to the rank of SI(AB) of Batch No.- 27/2021 .

15 ASIs (AB) had reported at SVSPA , WB, Barrackpore, WB to undergo the aforesaid training. 14 ASIs (AB) candidates out of 15 ASIs(AB), completed the training and appeared in the final examination in all subjects and qualified successfully.

The results of the same were placed before the 'Board of control' for examination and promotion for perusal and approval for taking next course of action.

Decision:- The Board examined the results and approved of the same for next course of action 14 (fourteen) SIs(AB) are found to have qualified for promotion.

3. IGP SVSPA has submitted for kind consideration of the board that the PPT for various ranks are being conducted by SVSPA, during the course of training requests come from the units for left out candidates to have their training conducted and this results in creation of very small batches of trainees resulting in wasteful usage of training resources. It was proposed that the training batches to be of

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minimum 30 (thirty) member strength and efforts to be made to club the training to avoid small batches being sent.

Decision:- DIG (HQ) to look into the matter and prepare lists accordingly to avoid small batches as far as possible.

4. Forgoing prayers submitted by Police personnel :-

- The following 03 (three) Police personnel of different district/ unit/ Commissionerate were posted on promotion to the next higher rank to the different districts/unit as mentioned below:-
- They have submitted prayers for forgoing their promotion due to various reasons.
- Their matters will be placed before BOC for decision.

Decision: After discussion the board member have accepted the prayers of above mentioned Police personnel to forgo the promotion to the rank of ASI(UB/AB) .

Commissionerate of police of Howrah PC, SP Birbhum and DIG, EB, WB are requested to strictly follow the GO No.- 9120/F dtd- 13.11.2000 of finance department , Govt. of West Bengal in this regard . They will not be entitled to any benefit under CAS, 1990 and it should be recorded in their service books, With intimation to DIG(HQs.) , West Bengal.

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5. MISCELANIOUS:-**(i) Consideration of the prayer for getting promotional seniority benefit in respect of C/915 Ranjan Mondal of SAP, 3rd Bn. Barrackpore to the rank of ASI(UB)**

C/915 Ranjan Mondal of SAP, 3rd Bn. Barrackpore was posted on promotion to Murshidabad District to the rank of ASI(UB) vide this office memo no.- 810 (168)- Per/A – 25/2016, dtd- 13.07.2018 (SI. No.- 51). Subsequently posting order on promotion was modified and posted to Barrackpore Police Commissionerate vide Memo No.- 76(71) Per/A – 112/2018 , dtd- 12.02.2019 (SI No.- 18) of DIG(A), WB in

cancellation of his earlier posting order. Accordingly he joined this commissionerate on promotion and assumed the charge of superior duty as ASI(UB) on 06.06.2019 being departed from SAP 3rd Bn. Barrackpore on 05.06.2021. He was relieved from CBI w.e.f. 30.04.2019 at joined SAP 3rd Bn. Barrackpore on 31.05.2019 after availing 30 days Earned Leave w.e.f. 01.05.2019 to 30.05.2019. Which refers to order no.- 108/2019 (EO-IV) DTD- 29/04/2019 of SP, CBI, EO-IV, Kolkata and Order No.- 634 dtd- 31.05.2019 of CO, SAP 3rd Bn, Barrackpore as reported by Joint Commissioner of Police, Barrackpore vide his office memo no.- 717/RO , BKP PC dtd- 28.05.2021.

Now, ASI (UB)/180 Ranjan Mondal (formerly Constable/915 of SAP 3rd Bn, Barrackpore on deputation at CBI.) of Barrackpore PC wants to get promotional benefit and Pay fixation w.e.f. the date of promotion order i.e. 13.07.2018. His prayer may be accepted.

The matter was placed before BOC for examination and promotion for decision.

Decision-The member of the Board examined and allowed C/915 Ranjan Mondal of SAP 3rd, BKP to avail the promotion vide this office memo no.- 810(168)-Per/A , 25-2010 dtd- 13.07.2018. His seniority is fixed above his immediate junior C/1562 Priyotosh Kundu of Asansol Durgapur Police Commissionerate and all the promotional seniority benefits are allowed w.e.f. 13.07.2018.

(ii) Consideration of the prayer for promotion in respect of ASI(UB) 1124 Aminul Islam of Purba Medinipur Dist. to the rank of SI(UB) who previously submitted un-willingness.

ASI (UB) 1124 Aminul Islam of Purba Medinipur Dist. was posted on promotion to Purba Medinipur Dist. to the rank of SI(UB) vide memo no- 1254(168) Per/A dtd- 09.10.2018. He submitted prayer expressing his unwillingness to take promotion to rank of SI(UB) due to his physical illness. He also stated that he will never claim for the said promotion in future vide DO. No.- 4020 dtd-09.09.2020 of SP, Purba Medinipur.

In the meeting of the BOC for (E&P) held on 05.10.2020 , the Board members have accepted the prayer of Shri Islam to forgo the promotion to the rank of SI(UB), and decided that SP, Purba Medinipur will strictly follow the G.O. No. 9120-F dtd- 13.11.2000 of Finance Deptt, Audit Branch, Govt. of WB in this regard . The ASI will not be entitled to any benefit under CAS -1990 and it should be recorded in his service book.

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But presently ASI(UB) 1124 Aminul Islam of Purba Medinipur has submitted prayer to take promotion to the rank of SI(UB) informed by SP, Purba Medinipur vide his memo no.- 657/RO dtd- 02.07.2021.

His prayer may be accepted.

The matter was placed before BOC for examination and promotion for decision.

Decision :- The members of Board examined the matter and decided that promotion order of ASI (UB)/1124 Aminul Islam of Purba Medinipur to the rank of SI(UB) vide this office memo no.- 1254(168)Per/A , dtd- 09.10.2018 is allowed from date of joining with no backdated benefits.

(iii) Consideration for Promotion matter of Constable Monojit Bagish of Howrah Rural (Formerly C/ -849 of Howrah PC) which has been kept in closed cover in the earlier BOC for examination and promotion held on 28.06.2021 & 20.07.2021 respectively.

Claiming departmental promotion to the rank of ASI on provisional basis in terms of GO No.- 224 – P&AR (Vig.) Dated 12.06.1980, the Constable filed OA No.- 05 on 08.02.2021 before Honourable WBAT.

Honourable Tribunal disposed of the O.A, on 08.02.2021 with a direction on DIG(HQ) to consider the case of promoting the applicant on provisional basis due to pendency of the departmental proceeding in the light of the said G.O. as well as the order of the Honourable High Court passed in WBST 113 of 2018.

In terms of the order of Hon'ble Tribunal, an order was passed on 16.04.2021 by former DIG(HQ.) with the following decision :

“However, presently, State Assembly Election in West Bengal is going on and Model Code of conduct (MCC) is in force. Therefore, no promotion board can be held due to MCC guidelines.

Hence further decision in this matter will be taken after the period of MCC is over.”

Thereafter, BOC for (E & P) held on 28.06.2021. The member of the BOC discussed this matter and all the orders were perused. However, since in this case not only the DP is pending against the incumbent but a criminal case is also being contemplated against him in a related matter, it was decided not to grant him provisional promotion and to continue with closed cover proceedings.

Then the constable has also been closed cover in earlier BOC for (E & P) held on 20.07.2021. The members of the Board observed (Sl. No.-17) that presently name of C/849 Monojit Bagish of Howrah PC is not enlisted in the list of Range Board. However it has been decided in the BOC that a message will be sent to the concerned unit head to know the present status in c/w pending departmental proceeding vide EB , WB PROC. NO.- 01/2017 DTD- 02.03.2017 of the said Constable, so that the same may be placed before the next BOC to take a Final decision.

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Now, the Constable submitted contempt application before WBAT against Smt. Parul Kush Jain, IPS, DIG (HQ.), WB for not complying the direction Honourable Tribunal in spite of MCC is over. The Date of hearing of the contempt matter is fixed on 26.11.2021 to avoid any adverse order.

Decision :- The members of the Board in BOC dated 28.06.2021 examined the matter and decided that in the departmental proceeding, the charge against the C.O. is grave enough involving disproportionate assets to the tune of Rs. 97,17,740/- (Ninety seven lakh, seventeen thousand seven hundred forty only). Besides, criminal case is also being contemplated against him.

Hence, it was decided not to grant him provisional promotion at this stage and to continue with closed cover proceedings. Same decision was taken in BOC dated 20.07.2021.

Moreover since the order of hon'ble West Bengal Administrative tribunal dated 08/02/2021 mentions that "Deputy Inspector General (HQ.), WB respondent no. -7, to considered the case of promoting the applicant on provisional basis due to the pendency of the departmental proceedings in the light of memorandum dated June , 12, 1980, particularly the stipulations contained in paragraph 2(ii) thereof, and in view of the order of the hon'ble High Court, Calcutta dtd-18th, September 2018 passed in W.P.S.T. No.- 113 of 2018 by passing a reasoned order to be communicated to the parties within a period of 8 weeks from the date of presentation of the copy of this order downloaded from the internet/website, after considering the relevant records and after considering whether others similarly situated have been promoted or not, in accordance with law. The application is disposed of."

Hence it is decided that the decisions of BOC for 28/6/21 and 20/7/21 which were arrived at after perusing all the orders and discussions may be communicated to the constable as directed.

(iv) Promotion matter of following 02(two) Constables who have been kept in closed cover in the earlier BOC for examination and promotion held on 20.07.2021. Now they are unwilling to take promotion.
