**Rules :**

1. Short title and commencement :

- (1) These rules may be called the Recruitment Rules of Intelligence Officers in Intelligence Branch, West Bengal.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their Publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Mode of Appointment :

- (a) Appointment to the rank of Intelligence Officers in Intelligence Branch, West Bengal shall be made either on promotion from the rank of Assistant Intelligence Officer or on deputation basis.
- (b) For the purpose of promotion, selection will be made by the Board of Examination and Promotion. The meeting of the Board for considering promotion to the rank of Intelligence Officer will be headed by the Director General and Inspector General of Police, West Bengal. The Director/Addl. Director, IB, West Bengal will be a member of the Board.
- (c) A total of 60% of the posts of Intelligence Officer called Cadre Quota will be filled up by promotion from the eligible candidates of feeder post of Assistant Intelligence Officer by the Board of Control for Examination and Promotion following the rules of seniority, pre-promotional training and examination relevant in case of such promotions in equivalent rank of West Bengal Police. The syllabus, duration of training, pattern of examination, qualifying marks etc. shall be decided by the Board of Control for Training in the Training Branch, West Bengal.
- (d) The remaining 40% of the posts of Intelligence Officer will be filled up on deputation basis from West Bengal Police and Kolkata Police. Not more than 10% of the posts may be filled up on deputation from Kolkata Police as required by the Intelligence Branch, West Bengal. The West Bengal Police may count these posts as deputation reserve accordingly.
- (e) Depending on the necessity of the Intelligence Branch, West Bengal, not more than 10% of posts of Intelligence Officer under deputation quota may be filled up by officers of equivalent rank belonging to other intelligence/law enforcement agency.
- (f) The period of deputation will be initially for a period of 4 (four) years which may be extended up to 7 (seven) years. When an Intelligence Officer on deputation is identified as "hardcore" in Intelligence he/she may be retained in Intelligence Branch, West Bengal for any specific period beyond 7(seven) years with the approval of the State Government. If a hardcore officer is permanently required in the Intelligence Branch, he/she may be absorbed

in the Intelligence Cadre against existing vacancy of cadre post with the approval of the Government.

3. Eligibility Criteria.

(a) For Promotion from Cadre Posts.

The Assistant Intelligence Officers of the Intelligence Cadre either recruited directly or appointed on promotion having completed 8 years of service in that rank shall be eligible to undergo pre-promotional training followed by examination to be conducted by the Board of Control for Examination and Promotion. However, the promotion shall be on the basis of seniority-cum-merit as per common gradation list maintained for the Assistant Intelligence Officers and the pre-promotional training having 70% weightage and the length & record of service having 30% weightage.

(b) For Deputation.

All Inspectors of Police of West Bengal Police and Kolkata Police having a minimum of two years of service in that rank are eligible for deputation to the Intelligence Branch as Intelligence Officers in terms of Rule 2(d) above. The officers of equivalent rank from any other law enforcement/intelligence agency or police force under the Govt. of West Bengal or any other State or the Central Government having a minimum of two years of service in the substantive rank are eligible for deputation to the Intelligence Branch, West Bengal as Intelligence Officers in terms of Rule 2(e) above.

4. Appointing Authority.

Inspector General of Police, Headquarters, West Bengal shall be the appointing authority for the post.

5. Overriding Provision.

The provision of these rules shall have effect notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained elsewhere in any other rules or regulations for the time being in force, regulating the recruitment to the post mentioned in these rules.

6. Repeal and Savings.

Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, the persons appointed on regular basis or substantively to the posts covered under these rules prior to coming into force of these rules shall be deemed to have been appointed under these rules.

1. Short title and commencement.
  - (i) These rules may be called the Recruitment Rules of Assistant Intelligence Officer in Intelligence Branch, West Bengal.
  - (ii) These rules shall come into effect on the date of their Publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Recruiting Agency.
  - (a) Direct Recruitment (by Selection) to the posts of Assistant Intelligence Officer in the Intelligence Branch, West Bengal shall be made through the West Bengal Police Recruitment Board by inviting applications from eligible candidates through advertisement.
  - (b) Appointment by promotion to the post of Assistant Intelligence Officer in Intelligence Branch, West Bengal will be made by the Board of Control for Examination and Promotion in the West Bengal Police Headquarters wherein the Director/Additional Director Intelligence Branch, West Bengal shall be included as a member.
3. Method of Recruitment.
  - (a) 60% of the posts of Assistant Intelligence Officer in the Intelligence Branch, West Bengal (herein after called Cadre Quota) shall be filled up by selection and by promotion from amongst the eligible candidates in the following manner :
    - (i) 50% of the posts under Cadre Quota, i.e. 30% of the total posts (both permanent and temporary) are to be filled up by selection (direct recruitment) through the West Bengal Police Recruitment Board on the basis of a qualifying examination similar to that applicable to the post of Sub-Inspector of Police (Unarmed Branch) in the West Bengal Police.

Provided that a maximum of 10% of total vacancies in the direct recruitment quota may be filled through limited departmental examination from among the serving Intelligence Assistants (General Duty), Intelligence Assistants (GD & TD) and Senior Intelligence Assistants having requisite qualification and having completed five years of continuous and satisfactory services in Intelligence Branch, West Bengal. This limited departmental examination, shall be conducted by the West Bengal police Recruitment Board, for filling vacancies in exceptional and special circumstances only and not as a matter of routine and subject to the prior approval of the Government.
    - (ii) The remaining 50% of the posts under Cadre Quota i.e., 30% of the total posts are to be filled up by promotion from the rank of Senior Intelligence Assistant belonging to the Intelligence Cadre

by the Board of Control for Examination and Promotion in the West Bengal Police Headquarters following the rules of seniority, pre-promotional training and examination relevant in case of such promotions in equivalent rank of West Bengal Police.

- (b) A total of 40% of the posts of Assistant Intelligence Officer will be filled up on deputation basis from West Bengal Police and Kolkata Police. Not more than 10% of such posts may be drawn from Kolkata Police as required by the Intelligence Branch, West Bengal. The West Bengal Police may count these posts as deputation reserve accordingly.

Provided that depending on the necessity of the Intelligence Branch, West Bengal, not more than 10% of posts under deputation quota may be filled up by officers of equivalent rank belonging to other intelligence/law enforcement agencies.

- (c) The tenure of deputation will be initially for 4 (four) years which may be extended up to 7 (seven) years. When an officer on deputation is identified as “hardcore” in Intelligence he/she may be remained in Intelligence Branch, West Bengal for any specific period beyond 7 (Seven) years with the approval of the State Government. If a hardcore officer is permanently required in the Intelligence Branch, he/she may be absorbed in the Intelligence Cadre against existing vacancy of cadre post with the approval of the Government.

4. A) Eligibility Criteria of Candidates for Direct Recruitment.

- (i) Eligibility Criteria for direct recruitment to the posts shall be same as applicable to the post of Sub-Inspector of Police (Unarmed Branch) in West Bengal Police in all respects as approved by the Government from time to time. The process of selection like Preliminary Examination, Physical Measurement Test, Physical Efficiency Test, Final Combined Competitive Examination, Personality Test etc. shall be same as applicable to the post of Sub-Inspector of Police (Unarmed Branch) in West Bengal Police as approved by the Government from time to time.
- (ii) The final Merit List of provisionally selected candidates shall be prepared on the basis of the total marks obtained in the Final Competitive Examination and the Marks obtained in the Personality Test. The candidates who have failed to secure minimum passing mark in the Personality Test will not be considered for selection.

B) Eligibility Criteria for Promotion from Cadre Post.

The Senior Intelligence Assistants (SIA) of the Intelligence Cadre having completed 05 years of service as SIA shall be eligible to undergo pre-promotional training followed by departmental examination to be conducted by the Board of Control for examination and Promotion in the West Bengal Police Headquarters. However, the promotion shall be on the basis of seniority-cum-merit as per gradation list maintained for the Senior Intelligence Assistants and the pre-promotional training having 70% weightage and the length and record of service having 30% weightage. The syllabus, duration of training, pattern of examination, qualifying marks etc. shall be decided by the Board of Control for Training in the Training Branch, West Bengal.

C) Eligibility for Deputation.

All Sub-Inspectors/Sergeants of West Bengal Police and Kolkata Police, Supervisors Gr.-I and II in the Telecommunication Branch and the men in the rank of Subedar of Eastern Frontier Rifles having a minimum of four years of service in the rank are eligible for deputation to the Intelligence Branch as Assistant Intelligence Officers in terms of Rule 3(b) above. The officers of equivalent rank from any other law enforcement/intelligence agency or police force under the Government of West Bengal or any other State or the

Central Government having a minimum of four years of service in the substantive rank are eligible for deputation to the Intelligence Branch, West Bengal as Assistant Intelligence Officers in terms of the proviso to Rule 3(b) above.

5. Reservation of Posts.

The reservation of posts for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes categories during direct (open) recruitment shall be as per orders issued by the State Government from time to time.

Depending on the necessity of the Intelligence Branch, West Bengal, certain number (not more than 10%) of vacant posts in the Intelligence Cadre as may be determined by the Director/Additional Director IB West Bengal may be filled through direct recruitment in the rank of Assistant Intelligence Officer from among such persons who possess appropriate language skills in Indian/foreign languages or local dialects and/or has specific domain knowledge/skill or conversant with certain topography/terrain required for the purpose of intelligence collection, analysis and such other assistance to Intelligence Branch, West Bengal as may be required for its efficient functioning. The number of posts, specific areas of knowledge/skill required etc. should be intimated to the West Bengal Police Recruitment Board as the time of notifying the vacancies for recruitment.

6. Verification of Character & Antecedents.

All provisionally selected candidates shall be required to fill up a Verification Roll which shall be thoroughly enquired into by the concerned authority.

7. Medical Examination.

- (a) All provisionally selected candidates will be sent for Medical Examination at the State Government designated hospitals.
- (b) The selected candidates should be in good mental and physical health. They should be free from any deformity likely to interfere with efficient performance of their work.
- (c) The candidates will undergo all necessary medical tests as prescribed by the Department of Health and Family Welfare, Government of West Bengal from time to time.
- (d) The certificate of medical fitness will be issued by an authorized medical officer.

8. Appointment and Probation.

- (i) The Appointment, Probation and Confirmation shall be governed by the West Bengal Service (Appointment, Probation and Confirmation) Rules, 1979.
