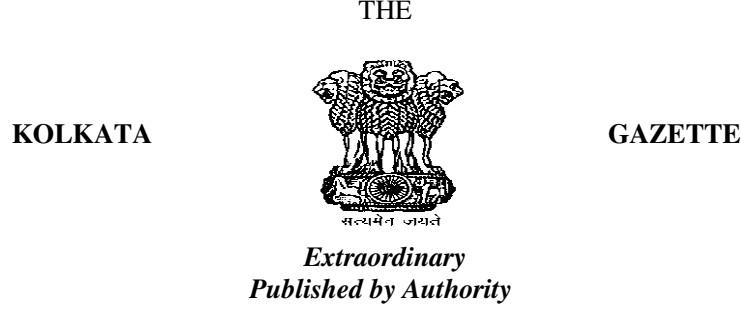

Following points were discussed and accepted unanimously during meeting:

1. IGP, SVSPA explained the result of the Final Examination of RCs of Batch No. 221/2021-2022 wherein out of 57 RCs, 01 is shown as detained another 01 is shown as Batch Reverted.
2. Members of BOC unanimously approved the result of RCS of Batch No. 221/2021-2022.
3. While explaining the special agenda point regarding modification of the process of approval of the result of the trainees, ADG(Trg.) WB said that in view of very short time being left between completion of the result and Passing Out Parade the very para marked as Sl. No. D at Page No. 73 of Training Manual of West Bengal Police (Vol.-I) requiring approval of result by BOC need be changed in the light of the Government Order No. 1037-PL/PI/8C-5/99 Pt. Dt. 21.02.2001. All the members of BOC agreed to the point. All the board members opined that henceforth, IGP, SVSPA will approve the result of the Basic Training of all categories and he will send copy of the same along with 'Analytical Review to the respective members of BOC for information.

To materialize the matter is to be sent to DG & IGP, West Bengal for his kind perusal and approval.

4. IGP, SVSPA proposed that the training of the Technical Staff of Coastal Security to be effective a provision of examination at the end of training should be there. The examination will consist of both Indoor and Outdoor Subject. The Members also opined that a proposal to be sent to DGP, Coastal Security, West Bengal so that the result sheet of the examination may be taken into consideration for preparing Inter-se Seniority of the trainees.
5. The members of the meeting pointed out that one member from Home (Police) Department to be nominated for the Board and the process in this regard has already been initiated.
