# Minutes of the meeting of BOC for Training held on 18.10.2022 at 15:00 hrs. at the office chamber of ADGP & IGP, AP, WB, Salt Lake, Kolkata

Shri Anuj Sharma, IPS, Additional Director General of Police (AP), West Bengal holding additional charge of Addl. Director General of Police, Training, West Bengal presided over the meeting.

Pursuant to the agenda No. 1 of the meeting, the result sheet of Final Examination of Junior Recruit Constables, Batch No. 09/22 including the list of eligible candidates for appearing in the examination and the list of detained candidates was placed before the members of the Board for their perusal and approval. The Board members after discussion over it approved the same accordingly.

Another miscellaneous agenda for seeking approval of marks distribution of the particular outdoor subject, "Weaponry' in the syllabus of Junior Recruit Constables was also considered by BOC

The existing syllabus was placed before the Board members and considering the present non-availability of ammunitions for .38" Revolver, the Board has approved the proposal for adding 12 marks of .38" Revolver firing (as prescribed in syllabus of Junior recruit constables) with the marks allotted for firing of 9 mm pistol. This approval is applicable for the Junior Recruit Constables, Batch No. 09/22 as well as for ongoing training of Recruit Constables, vide Batch No. 222/22.

BOC also discussed regarding "Banga Darshan" programme of ongoing Dy. SP (U/T) batch no. 70/2021-22. The said "Banga Darshan" has been conducted as per the existing syllabus of Dy. SP (U/T) which was approved by the Board of Control for Training on 07.06.2021. However, as the approved syllabus mentions about "Study Tour to bordering State", the same may be treated as "Study tour to bordering State, Banga Darshan i.e. Study Tour to selected places in West Bengal".

The 'Meeting' ended with a vote of thanks ro and from the Chair result sheet of supplementary examination of 08 detained Cadet SIs (UB), WBP of Batch No. 67/2021-22 and 02 detained Cadet SIs (AB) of Batch No. 38/2021-22 was placed before BOC for approval and board approved the same accordingly.

## Minutes of the meeting of BOC for Training held on 02.11.2022 at 13:00 hrs. at the office chamber of ADGP & IGP, AP, WB, Salt Lake, Kolkata

## 1. Board examined the Result Sheet of the Final Examination of 5905 Recruit Constables of Batch No. 222/22 of different STCs/TTCs including SVSPA:

- i) A total of 5944-Recruit Constables joined to undergo training at SVSPA, PTS Salua, STC SAP 4<sup>th</sup> Bn., Kasba, STC SAP 9<sup>th</sup> Bn, Sandhya, STC EFR 2<sup>nd</sup> Bn., STC SAP 13<sup>th</sup> Bn., Barjora, TTC SAP 12<sup>th</sup> Bn., TTC SAP 10<sup>th</sup> Bn., Dabgram, TTC SAP 1<sup>st</sup> Bn., Barrackpore, TTC SAP 2<sup>nd</sup> Bn., Barrackpore, TTC SAP 3<sup>rd</sup> Bn., Barrackpore, TTC SAP 6<sup>th</sup> Bn., Barrackpore, TTC SAP 7<sup>th</sup> Bn., Asansol and TTC SAP 11<sup>th</sup> Bn.
- ii) 12 (Twelve) Recruit Constable remained away from training for more than 25% of the training period and they have been reverted to the next batch.
- iii) 01 (One) Recruit Constable has been detained for remaining absent from training for more than 15% of the prescribed training duration.
- iv) 18 (Eighteen) Recruit Constable have tendered their resignation from service which was accepted by the controlling Authority.
- v) 03 (three) Recruit Constables have been discharged from service.
- vi) 05 (Five) Recruit Constable did not appear in any indoor and outdoor subjects.
- vii) A total of 5905 Recruit Constables appeared in the final examinations.
- viii) 14 Recruit Constable of different STCs appeared in one or some of the indoor and outdoor subjects. They will have to clear the subjects in which they did not appear.
- ix) 5891 Recruit Constables have completely passed in all the indoor and outdoor subjects.
- x) The result of the same is shared with the members of the 'Board of control for Training' for approval.

#### The Board unanimously resolved the following decision:-

- The Board approved the overall result of 5905- Recruit Constables of different STCs/TTCs and SVSPA of which 5891 have completely passed in the both indoor and outdoor subjects.
- ➤ 12 (Twelve) Recruit Constable who remained away from training for more than 25% of training duration, will be reverted to the next batch. They will attend their basic training along with the next batch. IGFP. SVSPA, Barrackpore will inform the concerned unit for basic training of batch reverted RCs
- ➤ Board also resolved that, 20 (twenty) [01 Detained, 05 Not Appeared, 14 Not Qualified] Recruit Constables who did not appear in different indoor or outdoor examinations, will be detained for that period so that they can appear in the Supplementary Examinations which will be held after one month

- from the date of passing out parade. IGP, SVSPA, Barrackpore will arrange for their supplementary examinations.
- Due to shortage of ammunition and non-availability even at the central armoury, RCs under training at STCs of SAP 3<sup>rd</sup> Bn., SAP 4<sup>th</sup> Bn., and SAP 7<sup>th</sup> Bn., did not have practical firing in respect of .38' revolver. Board resolved that marks awarded for firing of 9mm pistols will be proportionately scaled up to match with full marks prescribed for the weaponry subject in order to ensure parity with other trainees.
- RCs under training at SVSPA, Barrackpore had practical firing of 03 rounds of .38 revolver for each trainee due to lack of ammunition. In order to ensure parity, marks obtained by RCs in .38 revolver firing have been proportionately scaled up.
- > STC, SAP 4<sup>th</sup> Bn., reduced the full marks of practical firing in respect of 5.56 mm INSAS from 20 marks to 10 marks due to lack of ammunitions. In order to ensure parity, marks obtained by RCs of STC, SAP 4<sup>th</sup> Bn., in respect of 5.56 mm INSAS have been proportionately scaled up.
- > Due to such variation in actual firing owing to lack of ammunition. Due to such circumstances Board has decided not to award prize to best performer in respect of Weaponry subject for this batch.
- 2. Discussion of training syllabus of PPT for Wireless Operator to Wireless Supervisor (Gr.-II) (both Technical & Operational) and Wireless Supervisor (Gr.-I) to Wireless Inspector (both Technical & Operational). The suggested syllabus of the same was placed before the 'Board of Control for Training' for approval. Upon discussion the Board approved the syllabus of PPT for Wireless Operator to Wireless Supervisor (Gr.-II) (both Technical & Operational). Regarding syullabus for PPT of Wireless Supervisor (Grade-I) to Inspector, Board suggested modification in proposed mode of examination. Hence, their syllabus would be placed again in BOC for approval.
- 3. Board also resolved that henceforth IGP, SVSPA will hold meetings with all heads of STCs/TTCs and Principal PTS Salua at least once in a month to discuss training related matters.

After careful consideration the governor is pleased to accord approval to fix design and Ribbon of (i) Chief Minister's Police Medal for Commendable Service and (ii) Chief Minister's Police Medal for Outstanding Service as detailed below:-

#### (i) Chief Minister's Police Medal for Commendable Service :

#### Design and Description of Medal -

- a) The medal shall be round in shape measuring of 3.9 cm in diameter, made of metal alloy with silver gilt.
- b) The obverse will be embossed with logo of Biswa Bangla at the centre with national emblem on top and inscribed along the periphery 'Chief Minister's Police Medal' and 'Commendable Service' in English separated by two stars on both sides. The words 'West Bengal' shall be inscribed below the commendable service at the bottom.
- c) The reverse surface will be plain.
- d) The medal shall be suspended from the left breast of uniform by a ribbon 39 milimetres in width. The ribbon shall have two sky blue vertical strips of 13 mm each separated by a milky white strip of 13 mm.
- e) It will be worn to the left of the last medal awarded by the Government of India and on left of Prashansa Padak.

#### (ii) Chief Minister's Police Medal for Outstanding Service :

#### Design and description of Medal -

- a) The medal shall be round in shape measuring of 3.9 cm in diameter, made of metal alloy with gold gilt.
- b) The obverse will be embossed with logo of Biswa Bangla at the centre with national emblem on top and inscribed along the periphery 'Chief Minister's Police Medal' and 'Outstanding Service' in English separated by two stars on both sides. The words 'West Bengal' shall be inscribed below the outstanding service at the bottom.
- c) The reverse surface will be plain.
- d) The medal shall be suspended from the left breast of uniform by a ribbon 39 milimetres in width. The ribbon shall have three vertical strips of 13 mm each of navy blue, white and red from left to right.
- e) It will be worn to the left of the last medal awarded by the Government of India and on left of Nishtha Padak.
