#### Amendments

In the said rules, in CHAPTER II, under the heading "(A) General rules regarding Departmental Examinations",-

- (1) For rule (2), substitute the following rule :-
  - "2. The Public Service Commission, West Bengal, shall direct and control the Departmental Examinations for the services other than the Indian Administrative Service, West Bengal, Civil Service (Executive), Indian Police Service, West Bengal Police Service and Indian Forest Service."
- (2) For rule 2A, substitute the following rule :-
  - "2A. The Netaji Subhas Administrative Training Institute under the administrative control of the Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms, Government of West Bengal, shall direct and control the Departmental Examinations for Indian Administrative Service, West Bengal Civil Service (Executive), Indian Police Service, West Bengal Police Service and Indian Forest "Service."
