WHEREAS in respect of the premises of 06 nos. of EHV Sub Stations (under the jurisdiction of Purba Medinipur District) of West Bengal State Electricity Transmission Company Limited (WBSETCL), described in the Schedule below (hereinafter referred to as the said places), the Governor considers it necessary and expedient in the interest of Safety and Security of the said places that special pre-caution should be taken to prevent the entry of un-authorised persons.

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF CONTROL FOR EXAMINATION AND PROMOTION HELD ON 10.03.2026

A meeting of the Board of Control for Examination and Promotion was held on 10/03/2026 at 16:30 hrs. in the DGP'S Conference Hall at Bhabani Bhaban, Kolkata-27.

Shri Vineet Kumar Goyal, IPS, Additional Director General & Inspector General of Police (Administration), West Bengal in the rank of DGP, Chairman of the Board, presided over the meeting.

The following members of the Board attended the meeting:-

1. Shri Rishikesh Meena, IPS, Inspector General of Police, Organisation, West Bengal.
2. Shri Anoop Jaiswal, IPS, Inspector General of Police, CID, West Bengal (Co-opted Member).
3. Smt. Krishnakali Lahiri, IPS, Deputy Inspector General of Police (Planning & Welfare), West Bengal.
4. Shri Arindam Dutta Chowdhury, IPS, Deputy Inspector General of Police, (Administration), West Bengal.
5. Shri Dipanjan De, Sr. Deputy Secretary to the Govt. of West Bengal, Home and Hill Affairs Department.

The following points were discussed in the meeting of BOC for Examination & Promotion.

1. To examine Length-Cum-Record of Service of 24 (twenty four) Supervisor (Operational) Grade-II for promotion to the rank of Supervisor (Operational) Grade-I, in West Bengal Police Telecommunication Branch.

- DIG, Telecommunication, WB in the rank of IGP has sent Memo No. 348/P dated 25/02/2026 enclosing the Minutes of the meeting of WBP Telecommunication Range Board held on 25/02/2026 and Broad Sheet of 24 (twenty four) Supervisor (Operational) Grade-II for promotion to the rank of Supervisor (Operational) Grade-I in West Bengal Police Telecommunication Branch.
- The Range Board declared that 17 (seventeen) Supervisor (Operational) Grade-II are 'willing' & 'Fit' for promotion to their next higher rank and 07(seven) Supervisor (Operational) Grade-II are 'Fit' but 'Unwilling' for promotion.
- At present, there are 36 (thirty six) vacancies in the rank of Supervisor (Operational) Grade-I in West Bengal Police Telecommunication Branch as on 01/02/2026. It has also been stated that, according to 50-Point Roster of Supervisor(Operational) Grade-I the last vacancy i.e. 44th Point of 50-Point Roster (4th Cycle) was filled up during the last round of Promotion order issued and the vacancy will be filled up from 45th Point of 50-Point Roster (4th Cycle) of Supervisor(Operational) Grade-I.
- The L-C-R-S has been placed before the 'Board of Control for Examination and Promotion' for perusal and approval.

DECISION: The BOC (E&P) examined the L-C-R-S of all the candidates as considered by the WBP Telecommunication Range Board held on 25/02/2026 for promotion of Supervisor (Operational) Grade-II to the rank of Supervisor (Operational) Grade-I in West Bengal Police Telecommunication Branch and approved the same for the next course of action.

Therefore, the members of the BOC (E&P) unanimously decided that promotion may be accorded to all the FIT & willing candidates to their next higher rank as Supervisor (Operational) Grade-I subject to the availability of vacancies and observing the formalities of 50 point roster.

The members of BOC (E&P) have further decided that the candidate(s) who did not participate in Refresher Course Training, promotion may be accorded to him/them on officiating basis. He/they shall be required to complete the prescribed PPT, including passing the Departmental Examination, in due course as per extant rules.

2. To examine the prayer submitted by SI(UB) Biplab Kumar Das of Darjeeling regarding rectification of promotional benefit retrospectively and seniority to the rank of SI(UB).

- IGP Malda Range vide his Memo No. 832/Adm. dated 31/12/2025 has forwarded fact finding report of SP, Malda vide Memo No. 1526/RO dated 27/11/2025 and SP, Dakshin Dinajpur vide Memo No. 1418/RO dated 15/12/2025 respectively as sought for by the BOC (E&P) held on 16/10/2025 regarding allowing promotional benefits and seniority retrospectively w.e.f. 02/08/2021 to SI (UB) Biplab Kumar Das of Darjeeling.
- ASI(UB)-552 Biplab Kumar Das of Dakshin Dinajpur was posted to Malda on promotion to the rank of SI(UB) vide Memo No. 507(168)/PER/A//PER/A-88/2021 dated 26/07/2021 of West Bengal Police Directorate. He took departure from Dakshin Dinajpur on 02/08/2021 in order to join Malda on promotion as SI (UB) but he could not join Malda due to the non-availability of vacancy in the rank of SI (UB) and he was returned back to Dakshin Dinajpur on 03/08/2021.
- Subsequently, in modification of the earlier order, the officer was posted on deputation to Malda District on promotion to the rank of SI(UB) from Dakshin Dinajpur District vide Memo No. 758(18)/PER/A//PER/A-69/2019 dated 28/09/2021 of West Bengal Police Directorate. However, due to non-availability of vacancy in the rank of SI (UB) at Dakshin Dinajpur District, the officer could not be granted promotion there as well.
- Later, ASI(UB)-552 Biplab Kumar Das of Dakshin Dinajpur District was posted to Malda on promotion as SI(UB) vide Memo No. 416(24)/PER/A//PER/A-04/2021 dated 08/09/2022 of West Bengal Police Directorate and the incumbent assumed his charge as SI(UB) at Malda District on 10/09/2022.
- Now, he has prayed for grant of promotional benefits and seniority retrospectively from the date on which he reported to join Malda District on 02/08/2021 to assume his superior charge as SI(UB), but he was not allowed to join there due to non-availability of vacancy.
- The matter is placed before the 'Board of control for Examination and Promotion' for decision.

DECISION : The BOC (E&P) examined the relevant documents and observed that SI(UB) Biplab Kumar Das of Darjeeling, formerly ASI(UB) of Dakshin Dinajpur, was transferred to Malda on promotion to the rank of SI (UB) vide Memo No. 507(168)/PER/A//PER/A-88/2021 dated 26/07/2021 of the West Bengal Police Directorate. However, he could not assume his superior charge at Malda District due to non-availability of vacancy in the rank of SI (UB) at that point of time.

Subsequently, the officer could not assume the charge of SI(UB) at Dakshin Dinajpur also due to non-availability of vacancy in the rank of SI (UB) in terms of modified order vide Memo No. 758(18)/PER/A//PER/A-69/2019 dated 28/09/2021 of West Bengal Police Directorate.

No. 629-PL/PB/14M-18/2024 Dated 07.03.2024 — In recent times, a large number of youth from the state have fared very well in sports events at both National and International levels, bringing name and fame to the country and state of origin. In appreciation of their achievements as well as to encourage more people to participate in sports, it has been decided that the sports persons winning medals at National/International levels will be offered the opportunity of direct appointment to Government services under special dispensation as per the procedure given below:

1. Posts for recruitment of medal winner sports persons by way of special dispensation: A medal winner sportsperson will, subject to the category of medals won, be considered for appointment as Deputy Superintendent of Police/Inspector of Police (Unarmed and Armed Branches)/Sub-Inspector of Police (Unarmed and Armed Branches)/Sub-Inspector of Police (Instructor)/Asstt. Sub-Inspector of Police (Unarmed and Armed Branches)/Constable under West Bengal Police/Kolkata Police or as Section Officer/UDA/LDA/Group 'D' in the Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department for appointment.

2. Vacancies for recruitment:

These posts of Deputy Superintendent of Police/Inspector of Police (Unarmed and Armed Branches)/Sub-Inspector of Police (Unarmed and Armed Branches)/Sub-Inspector of Police (Instructor)/Asstt. Sub-Inspector of Police (Unarmed and Armed Branches)/Constable under West Bengal Police/Kolkata Police or Section Officer/UDA/LDA/Group 'D' in the Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department shall be filled up by recruitment out of medal winner sportspersons under special dispensation by creation of new posts without disturbing the existing posts under various categories as mentioned at para 3(D) of this notification.

3. Qualifications:

(A) The candidate should be an ordinary resident of the State of West Bengal.

(B) Educational qualification — Initially there will be no minimum educational qualification for being recruited as a medal winner sportsperson. They have to obtain necessary qualification in course of their job.

(C) Category of Medal Winners sportspersons:

The category wise classification of various sports events shall be as given below:

Category Category–A	Sporting Event/Championship 1-Olympic Games 2-Non-Invitational World Championship 3-Non-Invitational World Cup
Category–B	1-Asian Games 2-Commonwealth Games 3-Asian Championship 4-South Asian Games 5-World University Games/Championship 6-International Olympic Committee affiliated other international sports competitions
Category–C	1-National Games 2-National Championship (Senior) 3-Federation Cup National (Senior) 4-All India Inter State Championship (Senior) 5-All India Inter University Tournament

(D) Posts to be offered as per Categories of Medals: An outstanding sportsperson who has won as on the date of application the following categories of medals shall be eligible for recruitment to the following posts:

Sl. No.	Designation	Minimum Qualification
1	Deputy Superintendent of Police or Section Officer	Should have won gold/silver medal under Category–A.
2	Inspector of Police or UDA	Should have won gold/silver medal under Category–B or should have won bronze medal under Category–A Sports.
3	Sub-Inspector of Police or UDA	Should have won Bronze medal under Category–B Sports or should have won gold medal under Category–C.
4	Sub-Inspector of Police (Instructor) or UDA	Should have won Bronze medal under Category–B or should have won gold medal under Category–C and has obtained NIS Diploma (from LNIP Gwalior or Netaji Subhas National Sports Institute, Patiala) in any of the concerned sports.
5	Asstt. Sub-Inspector of Police or LDA	Should have won silver medal under Category–C.
6	Constable or Gr. ‘D’	Should have won bronze medal under Category–C.

4. Age — The candidate must have attained the minimum age of 18 years on the date of application.

5. (i) Submission of Application: For appointment as an outstanding sportsperson, an eligible candidate can submit applications to the Department of Youth Services and Sports through the portal. The copies of certificates/supporting documents related to the qualifications for the post shall be submitted along with the application form. The application can also be submitted physically.

(ii) Minimum Physical Standards: For recruitment in police, there should be minimum physical measurement criteria. However, there should not be any physical disability for recruitment as Police personnel.

(iii) Verification of Certificates and Selection: The sports certificates of the selected candidates/players will be verified from the concerned Sports Federation/Association. The Department of Youth Services and Sports will prepare the list of the selected candidates according to the date of their obtaining outstanding sports achievements. achievement and send their recommendation to the Home and Hill Affairs Department/ Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department.

(iv) Issue of order of appointment : The Home and Hill Affairs Department/ Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department will place the matter before appropriate authority for approval of the proposal for appointment of the selected candidates along with creation of the requisite number of posts under special dispensation. Upon approval of the proposal for appointment, the Home and Hill Affairs Department/ Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department will forward the list of the candidate(s) to the respective appointing authorities for the post(s) for issue of appointment letter. The respective appointing authorities for the post(s) will issue appointment letters after observing necessary formalities including satisfactory police verification and satisfactory medical examination.

6. Norms for promotion :

(1) All outstanding sportspersons who are recruited under this category will be eligible for promotion to the next higher rank according to the respective service rules prescribed for each post. However, existing Government employees who win medal in any sports event as per standards prescribed in para 3(D) shall be entitled to out-of-turn promotion to the next higher rank or to the rank to which he would have directly been appointed because of such achievement in sports had he not already been in Government service, whichever rank is higher.

(2) The following shall be the qualification for promotion of Instructor (Coach): If a player or a team earns any medal in Olympic Games/World Championship/Asian/Commonwealth Games in the performance/training of any coach, the concerned coach will be considered for out-of-turn promotion to the next higher rank or to the rank awarded to the player.

(3) All promotions under this category will be made by the respective appointing authorities in respect of the promotional post with the approval of the Home and Hill Affairs Department/ Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department.

7. Appointment :

The appointing authority shall appoint the selected candidates in the order in which they appear in the list prepared by the administrative Department. The appointing authority will issue appointment letters to the candidates with the direction that they should appear for service/training within the date specified for the purpose in the appointment letter.

8. Training, Probation, Confirmation and Seniority :

Training, probation confirmation and seniority of an employee appointed to Government service under these provisions shall be governed under the extant rules in this regard for such posts.

9. This shall not ordinarily be a matter of right and the State Government has the right to reject any application without assigning any reasons thereof.

10. The provision of this notification will have immediate effect.

11. The relevant rules for appointment to any of these posts as specified in Para 1 shall be amended, if necessary.

12. This has the concurrence of the Department of Youth Services and Sports vide their No. 36/Pr Secy(YSS)/24 dated 26.02.2024, the concurrence of the Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department vide their U.O. No. 101 dated 28.02.2024, the concurrence of the Law Department under their U/O Reference No 80 of 2024, the concurrence of the Finance Department vide their U.O.
